

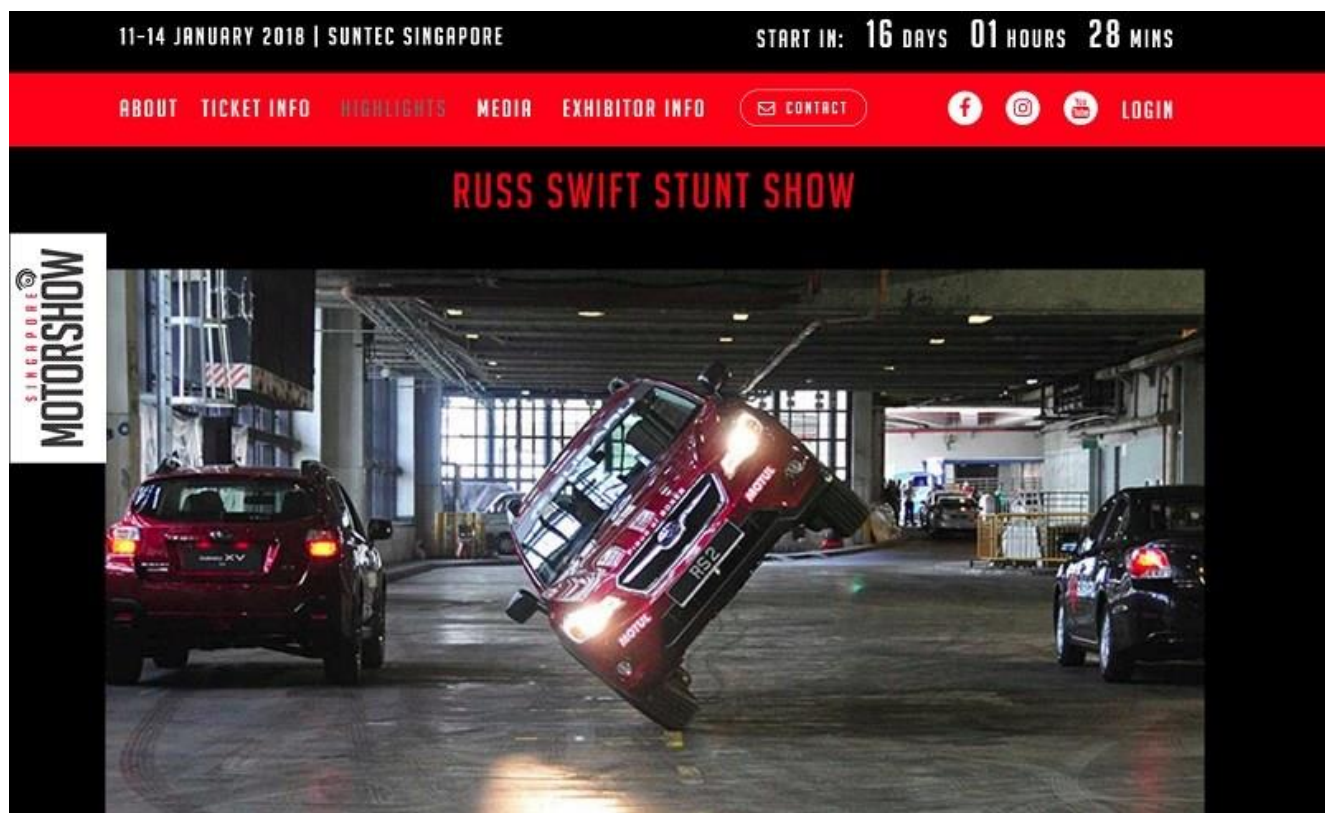
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WHAT TO EXPECT AT SINGAPORE MOTORSHOW 2018

The Singapore Motorshow 2018 will be back from 11th to 14th January 2018 at Suntec Singapore Convention & Exhibition Centre. This is their 13th Edition. Here is some information on what to expect during the show.

What to Expect at the Singapore Motorshow 2018

Over 170 cars will be on display and 24 launches from various automotive brands

Singapore, 22 December 2017 – The Singapore Motorshow, Singapore’s largest and most prestigious annual motoring event, will once again look to entertain visitors of all walks of life and ages with a variety of activities as it returns for the fourth year in a row. The 2018 show is the 13th edition of the Singapore Motorshow.

Happening between January 11 to 14, 2018 at Suntec Singapore Convention & Exhibition Centre, level 3 and 4, the Singapore Motorshow 2018 will see 24 brand new models from Citroën, Honda, Hyundai, Infiniti, Land Rover, Lexus, Subaru and Volkswagen. In addition, car buyers can look forward to exclusive automotive deals with more than 170 cars and concept cars on display from over 25 automotive brands. Tickets are free-of-charge and will be given out on a first-come-first-served basis. Subaru will also be giving away tickets to the stunt performance with purchase of their merchandise.
