Singapore, 26 December 2017 – The Singapore Motorshow, Singapore’s largest and most prestigious annual motoring event, will once again look to entertain visitors of all walks of life and ages with a variety of activities as it returns for the fourth year in a row. The 2018 show is the 13th edition of the Singapore Motorshow.

Proudly sponsored by Subaru, three-time Guinness World Record holder and British precision driver, Russ Swift will be making a return to thrill visitors with his stunt performances. Russ Swift’s performances are approximately 45 minutes long and there will be many timeslots throughout the four-day event. Tickets for Russ Swift’s show are separate from the event’s entrance ticket and will be available for collection an hour before each showtime at the Stunt Show (Wristband Collection) counter on level 4. Tickets are free-of-charge and will be given out on a first-come-first-served basis. Subaru will also be giving away tickets to the stunt performance with purchase of their merchandise.
